## Today's sentence:

"Jesus said, 'Father, if You will, take this cup of suffering away from Me. Not My will, however, but Your will be done.'"

Luke Chapter 22 verse 42

## Jesus predicts His betrayal and Peter's denial:

John Chapter 13 verses 21-27 and 30, and Mark Chapter 14 verses 27-31.

Is it I, Lord?

**ludas agrees to betray lesus**:

Surely not me!

Nor I!

I wouldn't do that.

ALL: It's not me either!

I tell you that before the rooster crows twice tonight, you will say three times that you do not know Me.

I will never say that, even if I have to die with You!

ALL: We will never leave You.

As the meal ended Jesus and the disciples got up and went to the Garden of Gethsemane on the Mount of Olives to pray, followed by Jesus's arrest (Matthew 26, 31-56; Mark 14 verses 32-52; Luke 22 verses 39-46).

3. Calvary's mournful mountain climb; There, adoring at His feet, Mark that miracle of time, God's own sacrifice complete; "It is finished", hear Him cry; Learn of Jesus Christ to die.

We invite all of you to imagine that you are sitting in the Garden of Gethsemane with the disciples.

My Father, if it is possible take this cup of suffering from Me ! Yet not what I want, but what You want.

Simon Peter, are you asleep? Weren't you able to stay awake for even one hour?

Keep watch and pray that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing but the flesh is weak.

My Father, if this cup of suffering cannot be taken away from Me unless I drink it. Your will be done.

Are you still sleeping?

Look! The hour has come for the Son of Man to be handed over to the power of sinners!

The man I kiss is the one you want. Arrest Him!

## Jesus is denied by Peter:

Luke Chapter 22 verses 54-62.

You too were with Jesus of Galilee.

I don't even know Him.

You are one of them, too.

No. I'm not.

A little while later the bystanders accused him:

ALL: You can't deny that you are one of them, because you are from Galilee too.

I swear that I am telling the truth! May God punish me if I am not! I do not know the man you are talking about.

Before the rooster crows twice you will deny Me three times.
